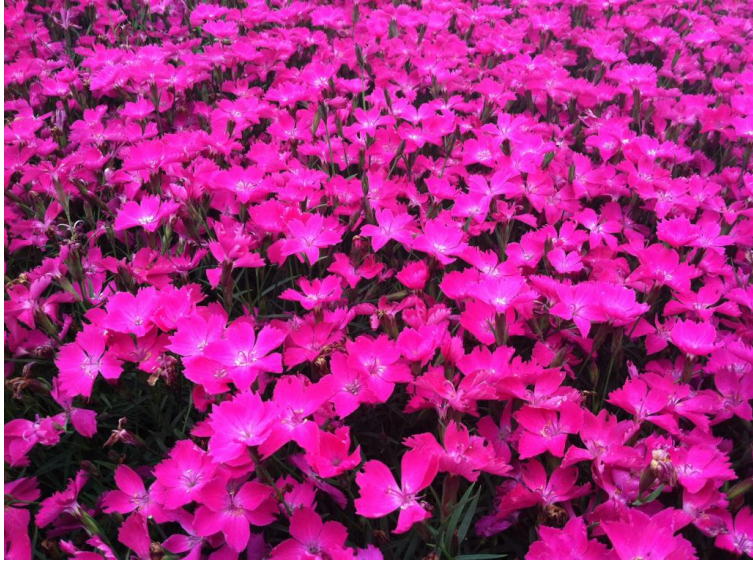


Fragrant Kahori Dianthus

Dianthus ‘Kahori’

- **Use:** A selection of the Border Pinks, a group of Dianthus that are a favourite for planting in rock gardens or using as a border edging. Well suited for edging and in the rock garden. Shear plants back lightly after blooming to maintain a tight, compact habit. Plants require good drainage and are an excellent choice for hot dry sites or gravelly soils. Combines beautifully with other low alpine plants. Attractive to butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 6-12” tall x 12” wide and continues to spread by underground shoots.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Forms a clump of grassy, grey-green foliage.
- **Flower:** An abundance of medium pink, deliciously sweet flowers starting in May and continuing sporadically through most of the summer.
