## *Dianthus 'Key Lime Pie'*

- **Use:** This apple green color is everywhere these days. Especially paired with white, like it is on our Key Lime Pie Dianthus, it's fresh, unique and fun. This variety is part of a new series, the American Pie™ Dianthus series, specially bred varieties for especially large flowers. They grow on strong stems, and come with a heady, spicy scent, so they make phenomenal cut flowers. It'll bloom all over a neat, tidy plant, and continue flowering from early summer to early fall. **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 10-12" tall x 12" wide and continues to spread by underground shoots.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Forms a clump of grassy, grey-green foliage.
- **Flower:** A beautiful new hybrid, with amazingly delicious colors – pure white blooms with unique apple green centers. Blooms are carried on sturdy stems that do not flop. Great for picking, long-lasting cut flowers.
