

# Mountain Frost Pink Pom Pom Dianthus



## *Dianthus 'Mountain Frost Pink Pom Pom'*

- **Use:** Vivid and bright! An outstanding rebloomer, this small but mighty charmer delivers high-impact bright pink color late spring to fall. Fragrant flowers with deeply serrated petals shine against handsome bluish-gray foliage mounds. Dianthus, the ultimate cottage flower, is a versatile perennial at home in mixed borders, containers, butterfly, heirloom, and cutting gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Needs a sunny site with well-drained soil, but will tolerate some shade in the afternoon along with humidity. Regular watering during prolonged dry spells will be necessary. However, they are tolerant of short periods of dryness. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** The habit is compact and mounding to a height of about 10" tall and 12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4a-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** The evergreen, glaucous grey-green foliage provides a stark contrast for these shockingly showy flowers.
- **Flower:** Delightful rose-pink double flowers provide a bright burst of color in early spring, and appear continuously until autumn. The tidy mounding habit is nearly maintenance-free. A superb, long-lasting cut flower. May remain evergreen in warmer winter regions.
