Dianthus 'Peppermint Star'

- **Use:** 'Peppermint Star' has large, light pink flowers with defined red centers and toothed edges. Neat habit and good winter hardiness. Fragrant! Pink flowers with crimson centers appear between May and June. Dianthus species, reminiscent of our grandmothers' gardens, are excellent edging and rock garden plants. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 6-12" tall x 12" wide and continues to spread by underground shoots.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Plants produce a low, dense mound of attractive green-gray foliage.
- **Flower:** The bold color combination and spicy fragrance of this brilliant star shines with single lavender-pink flowers with red centers against the frosty blue-green foliage. A twinkling flash of color!
