

Dianthus Sugar Plum



Dianthus 'Sugar Plum' (USPP#21398)

- **Use:** The Scent First® series of Border Pinks recently arrived from England and are known for their spicy fragrance, compact habit and long season of bloom. Flowers have a spicy fragrance. Attractive to butterflies. Great cut flower. Excellent for edging, in rock gardens and containers. The flower petals of all types of Dianthus are edible.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established. Plants require good drainage and are an excellent choice for hot dry sites or gravelly soils.
- **Growth:** Compact mounding habit 12" tall x 12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, glaucous grey-green foliage provides a stark contrast for these shockingly bright flowers.
- **Flower:** Semi-double flowers featuring frilly, maroon, pink and white petals with a raspberry eye. Attractive to butterflies. Plants should be trimmed lightly after blooming to maintain their tight, compact mound.
