This low growing variety produces showy clusters of fragrant flowers. Ideal for containers or for edging borders. Very easy to grow and low maintenance!

Dianthus barbatus "Barbarini Series"

- **Use:** With its attractive, full size Sweet William–type flower heads and extended bloom time, Barbarini® is well suited for perennial borders, mass plantings, patio planters and mixed containers. Butterflies love the intense color, and it is a deer resistant plant. (In times of extended drought Dianthus may need protection when deer become ravenous.)
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 4-8" tall(10-" in bloom) x 4-8" wide and continues to spread by underground shoots.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 2a-9b, Perennial / Reseeding Biennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Plants produce a low, dense mound of attractive green foliage.
- **Flower:** This dwarf hybrid strain produces showy clusters of fragrant flowers with colorful petals. Repeat blooms if promptly sheared after spring flush and can continue into fall.
