## ***Dicentra 'Titanium' PPAF***

- **Use:** Absolutely one of the most pure, true white flowers we've seen in ages. The floral display of this Dicentra is stunning against the soft blue-green foliage. Exceptional vigor and easy culture make this new Bleeding Heart a garden essential in the shade garden. In their natural habitat they are found in moist soils in the cool margins of woodlands.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun to shade. Dicentras are happy in any good garden soil that is fertile but not too heavy. If you have clay soil it must be amended. Enrich the soil with plenty of leaf mould before planting and apply a mulch in autumn, too. A light fertilizing in March will help enormously.
- **Growth:** Grows 9-18" tall and 14" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The blue-green, fern-like foliage forms a soft mound, and is a lovely foil to other plants.
- **Flower:** Racemes of white, heart-shaped flowers; the flowers hang on arching stems.
