## *Dietes iridiodes* 'Orange Drop'

- **Use:** Creamy white flowers with a touch of intense orange bloom spring through fall. Perfect for mixed borders and beds. Drought tolerant. Useful in rock gardens, near swimming pools. Can also be grown in a container. While no plant is 100% deer-proof, 'Orange Drop' is typically left alone by deer in favor of tastier options.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water when top 3 in of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Clumping, vertical growth habit, reaching 3 to 4 feet tall and 2 to 3 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7b-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous Long, grass-like blades may be evergreen in milder winters.
- **Flowers:** Attractive, cream iris-like flowers with orange drop blotches loom on stiff stalks over neat clumps.
