

HanaBee Series Foxglove



Digitali 'HanaBee'

- **Use:** An award-winning, compact foxglove series known for its, multi-branched, firework-like, blooms (white, pink, or deep rose) that bloom from the base. Developed by Takii Europe, this first-year flowering perennial is ideal for containers, reaching 16–24 inches in height, and is highly attractive to pollinators. The name "HanaBee" is derived from hanabi, the Japanese word for fireworks, combined with "bee" to signify its appeal to pollinators.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun– part shade, very easy to please. Provide acidic (most GA soil already is), well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 16-24" tall or more and 18" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial; reseeding biennial/ perennial; Make sure that heavy mulch is removed around the plants to allow seeds to drop and sprout.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. In addition to its superior flower quality, the ovate to lance-shaped, toothed, dark green leaves are small creating a perfectly balanced plant.
- **Flower:** Compact spikes display showy, large, tubular flowers with a speckled throat inside. Flowers are sterile which make them long lasting and repeat blooming.
