Echinacea 'Artisan Yellow Ombre'

- <u>Use:</u> This All American Select winner, with an intense golden yellow bloom along with graduated colors of yellow, is a gem in the garden. AAS Judges were impressed with the uniform growth habit, vibrantly colored flowers, and multi-branched plants that produce a prolific number of blooms. Deer resistant.
- **<u>Exposure/Soil</u>**: Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- *Growth:* Quickly reaches 24 to 26 in. tall, 16 to 22 in. wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 4a-10b; Perennial
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Dark green oval leaves are rough to the touch.
 - **Flower:** Very large (3-4"), single flowers that open intense golden yellow and soften as they age. The flowers maintain their vivid, saturated color all season. They sustain butterflies and bees, and the dried end-of-season seed heads that follow provide food for songbirds and add garden interest as well. The flowers are long lasting and make excellent cuts for floral displays.
