

# Cheyenne Spirit Coneflower



Does not require a lot of water and offers a wide range of uses from the perennial border, in a mass landscape planting, in a butterfly garden or as a cut flower.

## *Echinacea 'Cheyenne Spirit'*

- **Use:** This perennial captures the spirit of the North American plains by producing a delightful mix of flower colors from rich purple, pink, red and orange tones to lighter yellows, creams and white. This wide range of flower colors on well branched, durable plants are sure to please the color preferences of any gardener. As a specimen, in borders, or massed. Good choice for meadow or prairie gardens. Deer resistant, drought tolerant. Attracts butterflies. Winner of both the highly coveted Fleuroselect Gold Medal and an All-America Selection.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 24” in. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long oval leaves.
- **Flower:** Bright daisies of cream, yellow, gold, orange, scarlet, red, and purple top these stocky little plants from midsummer all the way into fall, replacing themselves without you having to cut or deadhead them. Every color in the mix reaches about the same size, and the flowers are very long-lasting in garden or vase.
