Echinacea 'Double Scoop Cranberry'

- **Use:** Such a rare color for Echinacea, this selection boasts saturated cranberry red, double pom-pom flowers that don't bleach out as they age, putting on a sizzling hot show of color in the landscape for several months beginning in early summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun-part sun(6+hr).. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 24-26" tall " in. tall and 16-22" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long oval leaves.
- **Flower:** Praised for their cheerful brightly colored flowers, cone-flowers are a mainstay in today's garden. Be sure to leave some spent blooms on the plants in the fall because their seeds provide winter food for finches and other birds. The dried seed heads also provide architectural interest in the winter.
