

Double Scoop Orangeberry Coneflower



Echinacea 'Double Scoop Orangeberry'

- **Use:** Such a rare color for Echinacea, this selection boasts saturated orange-red, double pom-pom flowers that don't bleach out as they age, putting on a sizzling hot show of color in the landscape for several months beginning in early summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun-part sun(6+hr).. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 24-26" tall " in. tall and 16-22" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long oval leaves.
- **Flower:** Delectable sherbet tones: A scoop of raspberry pink sits atop draping tangerine orange petals. It will quickly form a dense, well-branched clump offering dozens of blossoms for cutting.

Easy to grow and unusual wildflower! Butterflies love the flowers and birds love the seeds.
