

Julia Butterfly Coneflower



Echinacea 'Julia Butterfly'

Strong, well-branched stems. Expect lots of 'butterfly kisses' as they flit and flutter throughout this lovely plant to sip nectar from the vibrant blooms. Echinacea provide a spectacular show in any sunny summer border.

- **Use:** Named after the Dryas julia Longwing butterfly, this compact fragrant coneflower is as vividly beautiful as its namesake. Offering loads of flowers all summer in orange shades, the 4" blossoms will turn more golden orange as they age. Stunning.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun-part sun(6+hr).. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 15-18" tall " in. tall and 18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long oval leaves.
- **Flower:** Single, brilliant orange petals, maturing to golden orange, are centered around a coppery red cone. This robust grower will bring months of bold color and lots of winged friends to the border.
