

'Kim's Knee High' Coneflower



Echinacea 'Kim's Knee High'

- **Use:** A new dwarf selection of the wonderful native purple coneflower. Purple coneflower is extremely drought-tolerant, although it does favor improved garden conditions. Beloved by butterflies and deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 24" in. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long oval leaves.
- **Flower:** The large, fragrant flowers bloom from July to October. Each flower head has rigidly reflexed, rosy-pink petals that give a truly unique look to this selection.
