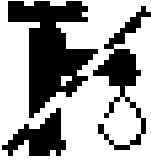
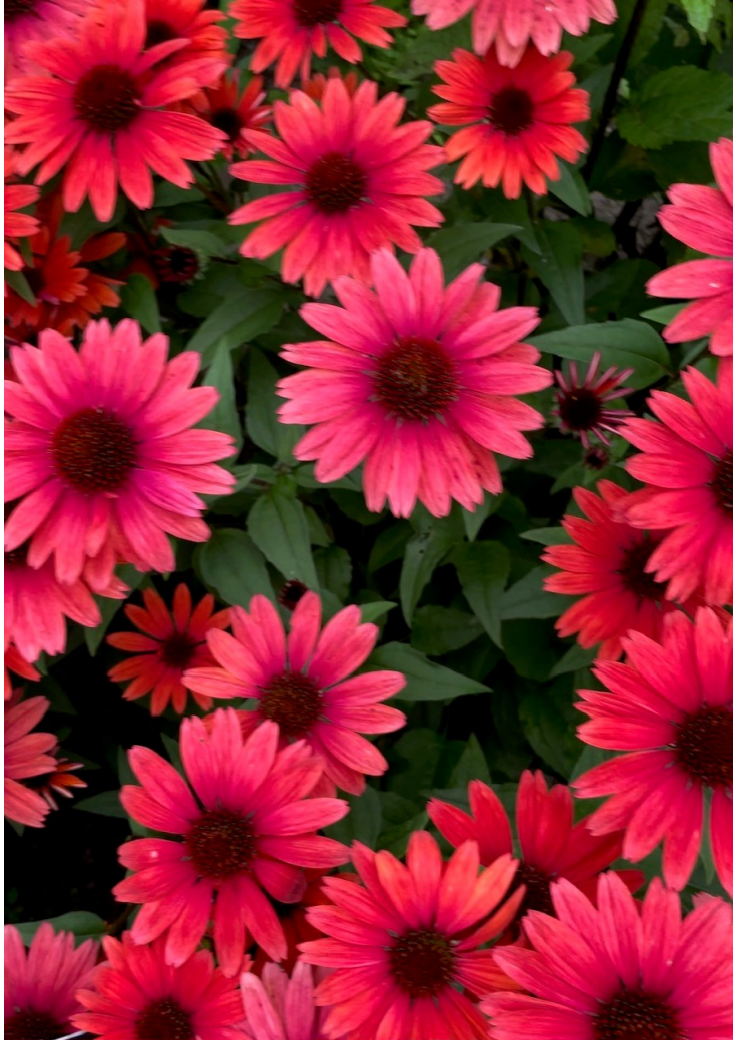


Panama Red Coneflower



Echinacea 'Panama Red'

- **Use:** Vibrant scarlet-red blooms on upright burgundy-red stems top this sturdy, compact plant. A fuss-free, cheerful choice for a sunny, easy-care low summer border. Drought tolerant and hardy, with prolific flowering over an exceptionally long season. Deer resistant, but occasionally deer may nibble some flowers so be proactive with a liquid repellent.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 12 to 14 in. tall and 14-16 in wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green oval leaves are rough to the touch.
- **Flower:** This compact and robust plant is positively overloaded with flame red blooms from late spring all throughout the summer. The showy, sun-loving blossoms are magnets for butterflies and seem to hold the warmth of the sun in each vivid, pointed red petal. Coneflowers have a long bloom period and the large dried seed heads are a great food source for finches and other birds in the late summer and fall.

A native plant that is known for its medicinal purposes but is also fantastic in all kinds of gardens; rock gardens, prairie gardens and cottage gardens as well as containers in the full sun. A great attractor of butterflies, hummingbirds and pollinator bees. Makes good cut flowers.
