Plants bloom with showy, daisy-like flowers from mid-summer until first frost. Excellent flower for the perennial border, natural meadow, butterfly or pollinator garden, or wildflower garden. Deer resistant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- *Growth:* Quickly reaches 18-22 in. tall, 18-20 in. wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 3a-9b; Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. Dark green oval leaves are rough to the touch which keeps the deer away.
- **Flower:** Flowers early spring through summer in an array of orange-red blooms with sunset undertones..
