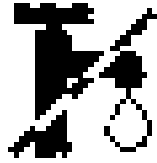


Red Ombre Coneflower



Echinacea 'Artisan Red Ombre'

- **Use:** This selection, part of the Artisan™ Collection, produces very large, single flowers with petals that open red and age to rusty-orange shades surrounding a spiky, gold-brown cone centre. Ideal for sunny borders and growing in mixed containers. Attractive to butterflies. Excellent for cutting. Allow dried flower heads to remain on plants for wintering songbirds. An herbaceous perennial. Good choice for meadow or prairie gardens. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 24 to 26 in. tall, 16 to 22 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green oval leaves are rough to the touch.
- **Flower:** Flowers open intense red, softening to red-orange and rose shades with age. And of course, they attract butterflies and birds. This series offers highly branched, dense plants that flower uniformly and consistently for years and years, including the first one. Lovely as a cutflower.
