Echinacea 'Sombrero Baja Burgundy'(Balsombabur')

- **Use:** Deep burgundy daisies are vibrant, and free blooming for months from mid-summer until first frost. One of the best echinacea for cut flowers, ultimate butterfly magnet, and the top specimen for color in the sunny border. Allow dried flower heads to remain on plants for wintering songbirds. An herbaceous perennial. Good choice for meadow or prairie gardens. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 24 to 26 in. tall, 16 to 22 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green oval leaves are rough to the touch.
- **Flower:** Everyone loves the very large, deep violet-red blossoms of this vibrant coneflower. Lovely as a cutflower.
