

Hot Coral Sombrero Coneflower

**Easy to grow
wildflower that

- **Use:** Brilliant, hot coral blooms will electrify the summer border! An excellent cut flower that is a must-have for sunny gardens. This drought tolerant perennial was bred for cold hardiness and a compact form with prolific flowering over an exceptionally long season. Good choice for meadow or prairie gardens. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 24 to 26 in. tall, 16 to 22 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green oval leaves are rough to the touch.
- **Flower:** Very strong, well-branched, plants produce large single daisies in coral-pink color and bronze cones. Color is strong and lasts for months in the garden. The flowers are excellent for cutting and attract butterflies, hummingbirds and bees. Lovely as a cutflower.
