Echinacea 'Tomato Soup'

- **Use:** Brilliant red flowers offer color and a spicy fragrance all summer and well into fall. Strong, multi-branched stems grow quickly to form large clumps. A beautiful addition to the sunny perennial border or mixed bed. Attracts birds and butterflies. Deer resistant
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 30 in. tall, 24 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green oval leaves are rough to the touch.
- **Flower:** Bowlfuls of red, large fragrant blossoms (up to 5" across!). Plenty for cutting. Long blooming and easy to grow.
