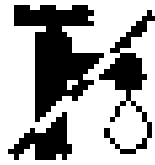


# Prarie Splendor Pink Coneflower



## *Echinacea purpurea* 'Prarie Splendor'

**Easy to grow wildflower!**

- **Use:** A shorter Echinacea that is more compact, contained and well-branched. 2007 Fleuroselect Gold Medal Award Winner. As a specimen, in borders, or massed. Good choice for meadow or prairie gardens. Deer resistant, drought tolerant. Attracts butterflies
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 24” in. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long oval leaves.
- **Flower:** Large 4-5" rose pink flowers. Starting about two weeks before the species and extending into fall.
