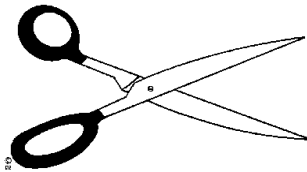


Amber Queen Barrenwort



When blossoms appear in spring on this highly floriferous shade dweller, the mass of yellow dainty spurs suggests a flock of miniature migratory birds in flight. Mature plants can produce up to 100 flower stems. **NEW ITEM!**



Epimedium 'Amber Queen'

- **Use:** A dazzling unique Epimedium that will catch your eye-it certainly caught ours! Epimediums are uncommon in the market and in high demand. A great addition to the shady landscape that only gets better with time. After years of building up stock, we are pleased to offer this dynamite variety. From Robin White. Striking woodland groundcover or shaded border edging.
- **Exposure/Soil: Prefers part sun!** Prefer a cool shaded area that is moist but well drained. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Grows 18-24" tall and 2-3' wide comes back every
- year.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deer resistant! Heart-shaped leaves are tinged with red in spring and fall. Green serrated foliage.
- **Flower:** The airy, delicate-looking flowers have bright yellow spurs with orange-red centers, looking light orange from a distance. Flowers are produced along the length of the flower stems, which are up to 24" long. The delicate-looking flowers have an airy feel, making it the perfect contrast to other shade items like Hosta. This is a vigorous Epimedium that produces up to 100 flower stems on a 4-year-old plant.
