Erysimum 'Canaries Yellow'

- **Use**: Features showy clusters of fragrant yellow flowers rising above the foliage from early spring to early fall. Wonderful for mixed borders, all containers and rock gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil**: Prefers full sun-part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth**: Grows 10-12" tall and 8-12" wide
- **Hardiness**: Zone 5a-9b; Perennial; Will reseed.
- **Foliage**: Evergreen; Small long green leaves.
- **Flower**: Clusters of clove-scented, yellow flowers appear from spring to summer above the lance-shaped, dark green leaves. Fragrant blooms two times a year if cut back after flowering.
