- <u>Use:</u> Baby Joe Dwarf Joe Pye Weed is the solution for butterfly lovers short on space in the garden. In late summer the plant blooms with flat topped heads of small, fragrant, mauve-purple flowers. The flowers are extremely attractive to butterflies and bees.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun or part shade. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer.
- <u>Growth</u>: This compact variety grows to a manageable 2-3' tall and limits its spread 1-2' wide.
- Hardiness: Zones 4-9 Perennial
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Bright green foliage.
- **Flower:** Gorgeous purple blooms that add sweet fragrance to the late-season garden, supplying butterflies, humming-birds, and bees with vital nectar. Also an attractive cut flower.
