Dwarf Joe Pye Weed





Use in perennial borders, cutting and pollinator gardens, naturalized areas and rain gardens. It looks lovely in cottage gardens and makes a stunning pot plant. It easily grows just about anywhere and is trouble-free as long as good light is available.

- Use: A teeny-tiny version of Joe-Pye Weed, 'Little Pye' only grows 10-12" high versus the 5' of the species. Butterflies, bees and other flying gems adore it, deer leave it alone. Its attractive seeds heads offer fantastic winter interest and provide food for birds. This plant is very attractive to butterflies and hummingbirds, making an excellent border plant due to its shorter height.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun or part shade. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 10-12" tall and wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zones 3-8; Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. Bright green foliage.
- <u>Flower:</u> Summer well into fall its airy sprays of fragrant, dusty-pink blossoms transform any garden into a pollinator haven.
