

Pink Frost Joe Pye Weed



Eupatorium fortune 'Pink Frost'

- **Use:** A variegated Joe Pye Weed! Dark green foliage splashed with creamy yellow unites with small clusters of deep pink flowers in late summer. Really shines in a moist site. Expect frequent butterfly visitors. Deer resistant. Can get weedy, but not invasive.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full shade or part shade. Tolerates dry shade. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 3' -4' ft tall and continues to clump. Eupatorium are great perennials to add stature to the back of the border without ever needing to be staked. An excellent performer that will tolerate a moist site.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Toothed green leaves, boldly edged in creamy yellow.
- **Flower:** Small clusters of deep-pink blooms appear in autumn. Lots of late summer color attractive to butterflies. With all this color, how could butterflies not be interested? Excellent cut flower.
