Euphorbia 'Hip Hop'

- <u>Use:</u> A heavier flowerer than most other varieties of Euphorbia, 'Hip Hop' produces a mass of small, white flowers. Has a tight and compact habit and will show its white flowers throughout the summer. Withstands heat and dry conditions very well. Great for combination planting or hanging baskets.
 - **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun, but will tolerate light shade. In our area they must have well-drained sandy soil to thrive in our wet winters. They are very drought tolerant. Requires a dry location with good drainage, especially in areas of high rainfall.
- Growth: Grows 20" tall and 36" wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 8-11; Tender Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. Glaucous blue leaves.
- **Flower:** After flowering, cut the plant to the ground to rejuvenate new shoots.
