

# Fragrant Maidenhair Fern



The delicate fronds of this fern bring a gentle look indoors or on a shady patio in summer.

## ***Adiantum raddianum 'Fragrantissimum'***

- **Use:** A popular, adaptable and durable houseplant fern. Displays graceful, open, arching, light green fronds with black stems and hint of soft fragrance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Needs uniform humidity, but do not mist. Maidenhair ferns thrive in neutral to acidic, loose, richly organic soil which is moist but not waterlogged. Prefers bright, filtered sunlight and is excellent as a houseplant or in a seasonal container. Protect from frost! Occasionally, water heavily so that excess water drains from the soil, flushing out accumulated salts from the root ball. Discard the drainage. DO NOT FORGET TO WATER!
- **Growth:** Will continue to grow in the pot to about 12-24" tall and wide spreading, but not very fast.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8b-11, Houseplant
- **Foliage:** Displays graceful, open, arching, light green fronds with black stems and hint of soft fragrance.
- **Flower:** No flowers.
