

Limelight Lady Fern



Athyrium otophorum 'Limelight Lady'

- **Use:** These lovely pastel highlights are maintained throughout the season and the fern may yet surprise growers by remaining evergreen in mild winters. The new foliage presents in a limey-pastel and adds drama to the overall appearance of this fern. The fronds mature to a medium green which causes a unique two-toned appearance through out the season. The lime-green with red stems will shine when planted next to yellows and blues.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun to shade. Keep surface of soil moist, but not soggy. Provide humus-rich, moist, but well-drained soil for best performance.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing 15 to 24 in. tall and 15-18" wide. Spreads by underground stems.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Delicate New growth is a soft lime-green accented with raspberry stripes on the structure from the stem to the midribs.
- Older fronds mature to green but new chartreuse growth creates a two-toned color to the clump.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers. Reproduces by spores on undersides of leaves.

Perfect for woodland gardens and next to ponds.
