

Red Beauty Fern



Painted Japanese Ferns are the most colorful of all the hardy ferns and 'Red Beauty' provides exceptional red centers with purple and silver along the stems and frond tips.

Athyrium x 'Red Beauty'

- **Use:** Add a spark of deep burgundy red to your garden's shady nooks with the bright hues of this handsome and hardy Japanese Painted Fern. The fronds have a blush of color along their midrib against a gray-green background.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun to shade. Keep surface of soil moist, but not soggy. Provide humus-rich, moist, but well-drained soil for best performance.
- **Growth:** Forms an upright clump 12-18 in. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Features gray-green fronds highlighted with burgundy red stems and veins. The darkest colors will typically be on the new growth with lighter shades on the older fronds, providing two tones of color in a single plant. (Don't use too much nitrogen or you may not get to enjoy the red stems.)
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers. Multiplies by spores on undersides of leaves.
