## Krauss' Gold Club Moss



## Selaginella kraussiana 'Aurea'

- <u>Use</u>: One of the most vigorous growing Tropical Club Mosses, this golden form adds a touch of brilliance to potted containers or terrarium design. The creeping stems create a dense mat, quickly covering the soil's surface. Grow as a miniature in a small pot or hanging basket. Remember to keep it evenly moist, and this moss will do well in low light. Its golden leaves when used in a pot plant can brighten an interior room.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Partial shade—shade. Indirect light indoors. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Needs to be kept constantly moist, but not sitting in water. If used as a houseplant we recommend a saucer with rocks underneath and fill water up to top of rocks to create a humid environment. DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN!
- **Growth**: Grows 1-2" high and outward growing continuously at a moderate pace.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 8-10; Houseplant/ Tender Perennial
- Foliage: Golden tips fading to yellow green with age make this Krauss Spikemoss stand out.
- <u>Flower:</u> No flowers are produced, but this "fern ally" makes spores upon small leafy spikes.
