Thelypteris ovata 'Lindheimeri'

- **Use:** Grows best at the edges of marshes and wet meadows, ditches, or woods; usually in rich, wet soil but not in standing water.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Light shade is preferred, wet to moist conditions, and a sandy acid soil. However, this fern readily adapts to other kinds of soil. It doesn't like too much standing water or excessive shade. Foliar disease and insect pests are rarely troublesome.
- **Growth:** Grows 3' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Upright but elegantly arching, light green fronds.
- **Flower:** none
