- **Use:** A compact mound of foliage covered with dark orange-red flowers over a long season; from mid-spring all the way into fall. New blooms appear above old, spent blooms for a tidy appearance without deadheading. Easy to grow in a sunny bed or border, and in containers. The flowers are lovely for cutting, too. This series know for covering spent flowers and keeping a cleaner look than other blanket flowers on the market.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Flower stalks to only 14 in. tall, mounds to 16-18 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Roughly textured gray-green leaves
- **Flower:** The flowers are large, many-petaled, and lovely. Expect them to reach 4 inches wide and cover old flowers. They begin blooming with the first warm weather -- typically in late spring -- and won't quit until nipped by fall frost!

Easy to grow wildflower!
