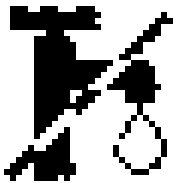


Barbican Red Blanket Flower



Gaillardia aristata 'Barbican Red'

- **Use:** Twice the flower power with a much more dense, rounded habit than others. A carefree perennial with vibrant flowers that bloom nearly nonstop all season. Perfect for hot sunny borders and cutting gardens. An excellent native plant for parts of your garden where hot, dry, poor soil conditions predominate. Thrives in sun and heat, nice touch in the rock garden or border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full— part sun. It tolerates a very wide range of climates, including hot/humid, hot/dry and cool/moist (in well-drained soil).
- **Growth:** Reaches 14 to 18 in. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. The flowers top mounds of roughly textured gray-green leaves
- **Flower:** Long-blooming, daisy-like flower are a deep red in the center and petals with slight yellow at the tips. This is an excellent pollinator plant attracting pollinators and butterflies. Individual flowers are 2 to 2 1/2" across.
