## Gaillardia aristata 'Barbican Yellow Red Ring'

- <u>Use:</u> With outstanding vigor, uniform size and summer-long bloom, Gaillardia Mesa™ Peach is an excellent native plant for parts of your garden where hot, dry, poor soil conditions predominate." Like the flat-topped mountains (mesas) after which it is named, the large blooms cover the top of this plant all season long. Thrives in sun and heat, nice touch in the rock garden or border.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full— part sun. It tolerates a very wide range of climates, including hot/humid, hot/dry and cool/moist (in well-drained soil).
- Growth: Reaches 14 to 18 in. tall and wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 4-9; Perennial
- Foliage: Semi-evergreen. The flowers top mounds of roughly textured gray-green leaves
- <u>Flower</u>: Long-blooming, daisy-like flower are a deep red in the center with yellow edges.. This is an excellent pollinator plant attracting bees and butterflies. Individual flowers are 2 to 2 1/2" across.
