- <u>Use:</u> Like the flat-topped mountains (mesas) after which it is named, the large blooms cover the top of this plant all season long. Thrives in sun and heat, nice touch in the rock garden or border.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full– part sun. It tolerates a very wide range of climates, including hot/humid, hot/dry and cool/moist (in welldrained soil).
 - Growth: Flower stalks to only 16 in. tall, mounds to 18 in. wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: 4-9; Perennial
- Foliage: Semi-evergreen. The flowers top mounds of roughly textured gray-green leaves
- **<u>Flower</u>:** With sunny yellow blossoms it is a long-blooming champion, like its relatives—flowers appear from spring to fall, which is one reason it was an All-America Selections winner for 2010.
