

# Whiskers Deep Rose Butterfly Whorl Gaura



Lots of blooms for 5 months! Most Gaura have long stems that rise above the clump of foliage with dainty flowers that move about in the breeze. This movement causes the blooms to look like little butterflies while attracting the real thing. Plant them in mass plantings for more impact. .



## *Gaura lindheimeri* 'Whisker Deep Rose'

- **Use:** They add a delicate touch to any garden from late spring to early fall and can even be used in cut flower arrangements. This North America native is heat and drought tolerant and not very appetizing to deer or rabbits. Great for areas where you can't get the hose in the summer. A lovely addition to the garden. Superb in containers, borders, beds, and open woodland gardens. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part sun, very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 16"- 18" tall, 14-16" wide, Cut back often for fullness.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8, Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Attractive green and red leaves.
- **Flower:** Have rosy-pink flowers with white stamens that look like whiskers. The rose-pink flowers flutter in the breeze at the end of wiry stems with narrow leaves climbing to the top.
