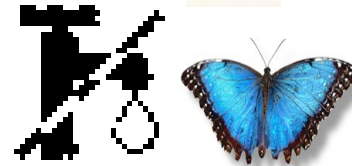


Ballerina Rose Whirling Butterflies



Lots of blooms for 5 months! Superb in containers, borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.



Gaura lindheimeri 'Ballerina Rose'

- **Use:** This variety has a more compact and mounding habit. Gaura put on a spectacular flower show throughout the spring, summer and the early fall months. They love hot spots with well-drained soils and also do great in containers. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part sun, very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 12-18” tall, 12-24” wide, Cut back occasionally for fullness.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Narrow, lance-shaped, stemless leaves (1-3” long) are occasionally spotted with maroon.
- **Flower:** Rose-pink blooms resembling small butterflies are borne at the top of tall, airy spikes. Will bloom late spring through fall with occasional removal of spent flower stalks to increase bloom time.
