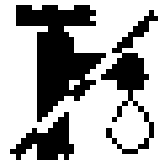


# Siskiyou Pink Butterfly Whorl Gaura



## *Gaura lindheimeri* 'Siskiyou Pink'

- **Use:** Once established it is very drought tolerant. Great for areas where you can't get the hose in the summer. A lovely addition to the garden. Superb in containers, borders, beds, and open woodland gardens. Deer resistant. Drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part sun, very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3.5' tall, 3 ft. wide, Cut back often for fullness.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8, perennial. Reseeds
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The red to green foliage likes full sunshine, the foliage is much redder than green.
- **Flower:** The shiny pink flowers are held above the foliage and put on a spectacular flower show throughout the Spring, Summer and early Fall months. Long bloom season!
