- <u>Use:</u> Once established it is very drought tolerant. Great for areas where you can't get the hose in the summer. A lovely addition to the garden. Superb in containers, borders, beds, and open woodland gardens. Deer resistant. Drought tolerant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Sun- part sun, very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate grower to 3.5' tall, 3 ft. wide, Cut back often for fullness.
- Hardiness: 3-8, perennial. Reseeds
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. The red to green foliage likes full sunshine, the foliage is much redder than green.
- <u>Flower:</u> The shiny pink flowers are held above the foliage and put on a spectacular flower show throughout the Spring, Summer and early Fall months. Long bloom season!
