

Garvinea® Gerbera Daisy



Gerbera 'Garvinea®'

- **Use:** In terms of flowering time Garvinea® outperforms other Gerberas and blooms from early spring until fall. Improved cold tolerance and disease resistance make this a winner in the garden!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun, but **prefers part sun or they will wilt from stress every afternoon!** Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established. **Prefers not to have water on the leaves.**
- **Growth:** Grows 12"-18 tall and wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. **Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter. If soil doesn't drain they will rot. NO RED CLAY. So some people have better luck with them in pots coming back.**
- **Foliage:** Deciduous, Large, green foliage.
- **Flower:** Big, showy daisy flowers in an array of colors spring to fall! Great for use as a cut flower and long-lasting! Remove old flowers to encourage new ones.

Keep water off leaves if possible. No sprinklers.
