Gerbera jamesonii 'Revolution'

- **Use:** Great for use in window boxes, planters, and in the garden! We also love them as a houseplant indoors in a sunny window or as a cutflower.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun, but **prefers part sun!** Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established. **Prefers not to have water on the leaves.**
- **Growth:** Grows 12" tall and comes back every
- year.
- **Hardiness:** 7b-10 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. **Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter. If soil doesn't drain they will rot. So some people have better luck with them in pots coming back**
- **Foliage:** Deciduous, Large, green foliage.
- **Flower:** Big, showy daisy flowers in an array of colors spring to fall! Great for use as a cut flower and long-lasting!
