

Dancing Wind Big Bluestem Grass



Low Maintenance and drought tolerant!

Andropogon gerardii 'Dancing Wind'

- **Use:** A Big Bluestem selected for its gorgeous late season color! bears green foliage that transforms to vivid red for autumn. Plants have the interesting 3-part bloom form that gives the native prairie plant its other common name, Turkey's Foot. Drought tolerant. Andropogon 'Dancing Wind' is a wonderful addition to grass or native-type plantings, or as a tall focal point in a flower garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun; Easy to grow in any soil except poorly drained.
- **Growth:** Reaches 4 to 5 ft. tall, 2 to 2½ ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. In late summer the green foliage becomes mingled with shades of soft red, which then increases and deepens to dark red in September, and turns scarlet after frost. By the end of the season, the plant is almost completely red.
- **Flower:** Feathery loose purple tinged flowers on stalks to 6 feet tall in summer that age to a buff color by late summer. Flowers often remain erect despite heavy snowfall.
