

Bunny Blue Sedge



Carex laxiculmis 'Hobb'

- **Use:** A low growing, evergreen, native sedge with silvery-blue foliage. Use as a ground cover or specimen plant for moist to average shady areas. Native plant. Useful on the edge of the water garden but dislikes complete submersion.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers moist, shady location. Needs ample water in hot dry locations.
- **Growth:** Grows to 8-12" tall and 12-16" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Though evergreen, plan to cut back the foliage in late winter to encourage fresh growth.
- **Flower:** The tiny, yellow flowers emerge in late spring but are not highly ornamental.
