

Frosty Curls Sedge



***Carex albula* 'Frosty Curls'**

- **Use:** The foliage is a silvery color and as the ends die back the blades will curl hence the name Frosty Curls Sedge. When planted on a hillside or when allowed to spill over a wall Frosty Curls Sedge gives the illusion of flowing water. Frosty Curls Sedge is an excellent choice for mixed containers as well, giving them movement. Useful on the edge of the water garden but dislikes complete submersion.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers moist, part sun to full shade location. Needs ample water in hot dry locations.
- **Growth:** Grows to 12" tall and 24" wide. Dense clumping habit.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Year round variegated foliage are a great accent plant.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
