Adds excellent texture to planters in all seasons. With its whimsical habit and low-maintenance nature it an eye-catching display year-round. Nice contrast with flowers.

Carex comans 'Frosted Curls'

- **Use:** A striking ornamental grass with pale silvery green grasslike leaves that curl gracefully towards the ground, delicately softening any landscape. Valuable for it's year round appeal, this decorative grass is one of the most beautiful ornamental grasses for the garden, and provides a lovely contrast against other broadleaf plants, mulch or gravel. It is particularly effective when planted on slopes, in containers or in other places where its foliage can cascade.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers moist, part sun to full shade location. Needs ample water in hot dry locations.
- **Growth:** Grows to 12-24" tall and wide. Dense clumping habit.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Features curling pale silvery green to frosted blue foliage with silvery tips.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
