Carex morrowii 'Ice Ballet'

- **Use:** Cool-season grasses put on most of their growth in spring before temperatures begin exceeding 75 degrees and in the fall when temperatures cool down. They generally maintain good color through the summer but won't grow much when it is hot. Cut back cool season grasses in very late winter in our area.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers moist, shady location. Needs ample water in hot dry locations.
- **Growth:** Grows to 24" tall and 24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. With dazzling half-inch-wide green leaves and creamy white edges, it brightens a shade garden.
- **Flower:** Brownish flowers in late spring are insignificant.
