Very easy to grow and great for shady, moist areas where other plants will not grow!



***Carex morrowii* 'Silver Sceptre'**

- **Use:** Cool-season grasses put on most of their growth in spring before temperatures begin exceeding 75 degrees and in the fall when temperatures cool down. They generally maintain good color through the summer but won't grow much when it is hot. Cut back cool season grasses in very late winter in our area.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers moist, shady location. Needs ample water in hot dry locations.
- **Growth:** Grows to 12" tall and 12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. With dazzling half-inch-wide green leaves and silvery white edges, it brightens a shade garden.
- **Flower:** Brownish flowers in late spring are insignificant.
