

Variegated Japanese Sedge



Carex oshimensis 'Evergold'

- **Use:** From containers to garden borders, this Carex series shines year-round in gardens large and small. The wispy, golden foliage provides a perfect complement to colorful shrubs and brightens shady corners. Useful on the edge of the water garden but dislikes complete submersion. Carex Everest will create a pleasing addition to your garden as it bends and sways with the warm summer breezes. A nice edger.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers a moist, well-drained soil with part shade. Very easy to maintain, requires little if any feeding and in early spring, cut back by 1/3 or simply tease out dead blades to spruce up appearance. Division is best done in the spring.
- **Growth:** Grows to 12-20" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Snowy white margins glow against the deep green blades-perfect for a moonlight stroll. Graceful arching mounds of evergreen foliage are low-maintenance
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers. On mature plants, tiny brown seed-heads may develop on panicles of short spikes.

Bright, colorful foliage, year round. Use as a groundcover, to edge a path or patio, or try tucking it into a living wall or window box.
